 - 02** Blinkit leads with 53 stores (42.7% market share).

 - 03** Store density: 8 per million residents — below the national benchmark of 15/million for mature markets.

 - 04** 14 areas have multiple platform choices; 47 are served by a single operator.

 - 05** Estimated workforce: 1488–2480 people across pickers, delivery partners, and managers.
